#### Fundraising

Knowledgeable and well-trained officers are critical to the success of the alumnae chapter. Training by the alumnae department at the biennial Convention includes recruitment and retention of members, programming, newsletter and web site development, fundraising and much more. Training ensures that your officers are knowledgeable in the policies and procedures of Alpha Phi International and are able to lead your chapter and keep it healthy. How does this affect you? FUNDRAISING! Each alumnae chapter should budget to send a delegate to every Convention. Past Convention costs have been approximately \$1200. The smart chapter puts aside half this amount every year. If your current budget consists mainly of dues and will not cover Convention costs, target fundraising efforts to help save this amount of money. Any fundraising efforts under the banner of Foundation must be donated to Alpha Phi Foundation; other efforts may be made to support Convention costs. It is equally important to send a delegate to Convention as it is to make a Foundation donation, perhaps more so. When your chapter is planning the budget and fundraising efforts, be sure to include sufficient funds for a delegate to the 2006 Convention so that your chapter will remain strong and help support Alpha Phi International in many valuable ways.
