Alpha Phi is pleased to offer a monthly installment plan to assist members in achieving lifetime membership status through manageable monthly payments.

Here's how the program works:

- Instead of paying the onetime membership fee of \$450, you may pay in twelve equal installments of \$37.50 plus a surcharge of \$1.13 per installment for a total monthly charge of \$38.63 (totaling \$463.56 over twelve months). Credit card payments only.
